# Inventory to the Jerry Elmer Lambdin Collection

## I. Biographical Note

Jerry Elmer Lambdin (1889-1960) served the Southern Baptist denomination for many years as the Sunday School Board's Baptist Young People's Union secretary. This department, later renamed the Training Union Department, wrote lessons for Southern Baptist Sunday Schools and also trained those who taught Sunday School classes. Born on 4 December 1889, Jerry Elmer Lambdin was one of fourteen children (Jim John, Orville, Clay, Joseph, Jack, Lula, Mattie, Lillie Mae, Lucy, Sarah, Mary) born to William Dempsey and Tennessee Delilah Satterfield Lambdin in Rutledge, Tennessee.

Lambdin attended Madison Academy in Rutledge, from 1893-1901 and, in 1908, the family moved to Knoxville, Tennessee, where he graduated from Knoxville City High School in 1913. During his high school years, Jerry Lambdin served as president of the Knox County Federation of the Baptist Young People's Union. Later, while a student at the University of Tennessee in Knoxville, Lambdin served as president of the Tennessee State Convention Baptist Young People's Union. He received his Bachelor of Arts degree in 1917, and later that same year, moved to Montgomery, Alabama, and served as the first state Baptist Young People's Union secretary in Alabama, until 1925.

The First World War interrupted Mr. Lambdin's duties as Union secretary in 1918, when he enlisted and served in a field artillery unit in Europe, during which time he reached the rank of Sergeant. He returned from Europe, in 1919, and married Ina Smith of Murfreesboro, Tennessee, on 17 December of that year. In 1921, Lambdin completed some graduate work at Southern Seminary in Louisville, Kentucky, and he attended Columbia University in New York City, for a short time in 1924.

In 1925, Jerry Lambdin took a position at the Sunday School Board of the Southern Baptist Convention in Nashville, Tennessee, as an associate of Landrum Pinson Leavell, then secretary of the Baptist Young People's Union. Upon Landrum Leavell's death in 1929, Jerry Lambdin became secretary of the Baptist Young People's Union, a position he kept until his death. During his tenure at the Sunday School Board, Mr. Lambdin's wife, Ina, worked beside him daily as editor of Junior and Intermediate lessons, periodicals, and promotional materials. In 1944, Lambdin completed yet more graduate work at George Peabody College in Nashville, and in 1947, Cumberland University in Lebanon, Tennessee, conferred upon Lambdin an honorary Doctor of Literature degree. Affectionately known as "Mr. Training Union," Jerry Lambdin retired on 31 December 1959. Less than a month later, on 24 January 1960, Mr. Lambdin suffered a stroke while teaching his Sunday School class at First Baptist Church in Nashville, and died later that day. Ina Lambdin continued her work as editor with the Training Union department until her death in 1975. ## II. Scope and Content Note

The Jerry Elmer Lambdin Collection, a series of the Sunday School Board (Southern Baptist Convention) Records, consists of twelve linear feet of material contained in twenty-five boxes. This collection contains information related to Jerry Lambdin's work as secretary of the Training Union department. The collection is arranged alphabetically by subject, the bulk of which is correspondence (including three bound volumes from his retirement) as well as materials related to the Baptist Training Union, such as lessons, convention programs, and speeches. Four boxes of material included in this collection belonged to Ina Lambdin, the bulk of which is information related to her book *Then Came Spring*. Also included in this collection are audio recordings of several of Jerry Lambdin's retirement functions and his funeral, photographs from tours of Europe and the United States, scrapbooks from various years, and several museum artifacts such as commemorative gavels from several conventions, Jerry Lambdin's academic regalia, and small figurines of Christ, the Disciples, and Judas Iscariot.
